Competitive Event Staffing

All advisors and chaperones may be required to assist with competitive events. Final assignments will be made and communicated prior to the conference.

Opening Session

On Sunday evening, all delegates (including adults) will be expected to attend the virtual Opening Session in which announcements will be made and any special instructions will be given. State Officer Candidates

State Officer Applications are due with your conference registration on the deadline listed in the State Officer Candidate Guide. Digital Badging

This year, Nevada DECA is excited to continue digital badging credentials for all interested Nevada DECA students! These micro-credential exams will be available online for all SCDC participants who register prior to the conference. Students who achieve a qualifying score will receive a digital badge from MBAResearch certifying them in that category. This program is sponsored by Nevada DECA and MBAResearch and will be provided free of charge to Nevada DECA members. The registration period for digital badging will occur prior to SCDC.
